


Southern Cheyenne Keyboard Layout



Notes

- To type a letter with the *breve* ˘, use the **Semicolon key** ;. The accent key is typed after the base vowel, so ā is typed a then **Semicolon**.
- To type the *long tilde* ˜, use the **Right-Bracket key** [. The accent key is typed between the two base vowels, so a˜ is typed a then **Right-Bracket** then a.
- The long ī vowel is on the **Left-Bracket key** [.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon** ; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Grave — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Shift+Right-Bracket — ” Shift+Backslash
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
