
Cree (Roman Orthography) Keyboard Layout

Notes

- All accents are typed before the base character: \hat{e} is typed Slash then e.
- To type the macron accent \bar{a} use the **Semicolon key**; \bar{a} is typed **Semicolon** then \bar{a} .
- To type the circumflex accent $\hat{}$ use the Slash key $\hat{}$. \hat{a} is typed Slash then \hat{a} .
- To type the acute accent 'use the Grave key'. \acute{a} is typed Grave then a.
- The letter **š** has its own key, **Left-Bracket**.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semi-colon**; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- The **Right-Alt** or **Option key** is used to type the linguistic character δ as well as another method for δ .
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, **Right-Alt** is either of the **Option** Keys.
 - ⊳ single: 'Shift+Grave 'Apostrophe
 - double: "Right Bracket "Shift+Right Bracket
 - single ← Right-Alt+Shift+9 → Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - b double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
