## Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: è is typed e then **Grave `**.
- To type the grave accent ` use the **Grave key `**. à is typed a then **Grave `**.
- To type the acute accent ´ use the **Slash key /**. á is typed a then **Slash /**.
- The letter ø has its own key, located on the **Semicolon key ;**.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon ;** is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, **Right-Alt** is either of the **Option Keys**.
  - single: ‘ Shift+Grave — ’ Apostrophe
  - double: “ Shift+Left Bracket — ” Shift+Right Bracket
  - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
