
## Denesųłine-Epsilon Keyboard Layout

## **Notes**

- To type the high-tone accent 'use the **Grave key** `after typing the vowel.  $\acute{a}$  is typed a then **Grave**.
- To type the nasal accent use the **Right-Bracket key** after typing the vowel. **q** is typed at then **Right-Bracket**.
- To type the high-nasal accent  $\dot{q}$  use the **Equals key** = after typing the vowel.  $\dot{q}$  is typed a then **Equals**.
- The l (barred-l),  $\varepsilon$  (epsilon), and l (glottal stop) letters have their own keys.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semi-colon**; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - □ single: 'Grave 'Apostrophe
  - □ double: "Shift+Equals "Shift+Right-Bracket
  - $\Box$  single  $\langle$  Right-Alt+Shift+9  $\longrightarrow$  Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - □ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
