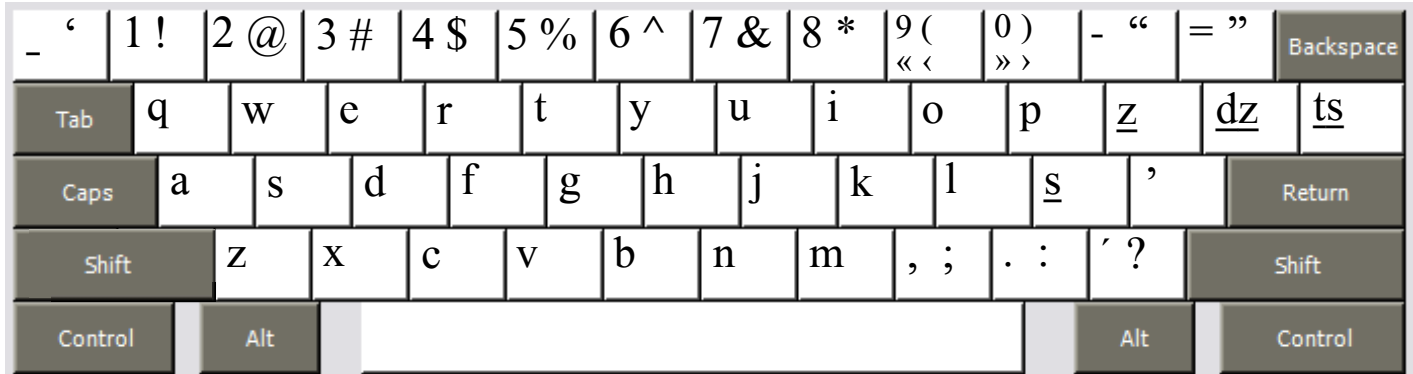


# DAKELH (CARRIER) KEYBOARD

## Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: *á* is typed **a** then **Slash /**.
- To type the acute accent ´, use the **Slash key /**. *é* is typed **e** then **Slash**.
- Each of the four underlined letters has its own key, for example, to type g use the **Semicolon key ;**. To type the capital versions: Dz and Ts, hold down the **Shift** key. Mac users can type the all-caps versions: DZ and TS, with **Caps-Lock** turned on. Windows users do not have this option and must instead use the **Grave key `** to type an underline accent for the all-caps versions. Always use these keys to type the underline accent, **never** use your word processor's underline formatting function.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Left Bracket [** is typed **Right-Alt+Left-Bracket** (Windows) **Option+Left Bracket** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - single: ‘ Shift-Grave — ’ Apostrophe
  - double: “ Shift+Hyphen — ” Shift+Equals
  - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
