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Notes

- To type the low-tone accent ` use the **Backquote key** ` after typing the vowel. **à** is typed **a** then **Backquote** `.
- To type the nasal accent ̣ use the **Left-Bracket key** [after typing the vowel. **á** is typed **a** then **Left-Bracket**.
- To type the low-nasal accent ̇ use the **Right-Bracket key**] after typing the vowel. **â** is typed **a** then **Right-Bracket**.
- The **ı** (*barred-l*) and **?** (*glottal stop*) letters have their own keys.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon ;** is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac). Dotted-i is also available using **Right-Alt+i** or **Option+i**.
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, **Right-Alt** is either of the **Option Keys**.
 - single: ‘ Shift+Backquote — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
