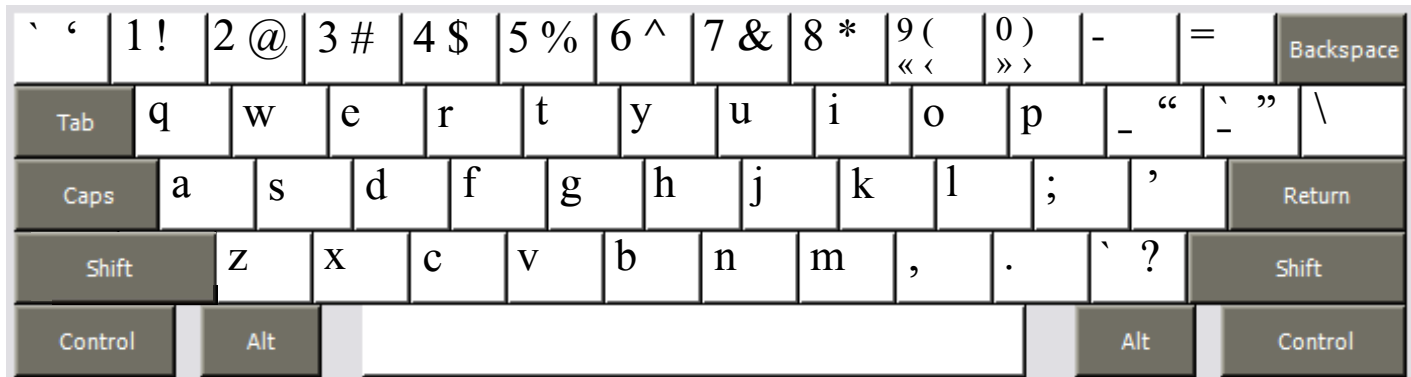


Tsek'ehne (Sekani) Keyboard

Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: e is typed **e** then **Left-bracket** [**.**
- To type the low-tone accent ` use the **Slash key /** — a is typed **a** then **Slash /**
- To type the nasal accent _ use the **Left-bracket** [**— a** is typed **a** then **Left-bracket** [**.**
- To type the low-tone nasal accent ` use the **Right-bracket**] — a is typed **a** then **Right-bracket**]
- You can type the original English punctuation marks by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option** key. The ***Slash /*** is typed **Right-Alt+Slash** (Windows) **Option+Slash** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - » single: ‘ Shift-Backquote — ’ Apostrophe
 - » double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - » single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - » double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0

- To type the low-tone accent ` use the **Slash key /** — \grave{a} is typed **a** then **Slash /**
- To type the nasal accent ⌑ use the **Left-bracket [** — \grave{a} is typed **a** then **Left-bracket [**
- To type the low-tone nasal accent ⌑ use the **Right-bracket]** — \grave{a} is typed **a** then **Right-bracket]**
- You can type the original English punctuation marks by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option** key. The **Slash /** is typed **Right-Alt+Slash** (Windows) **Option+Slash** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - » single: ‘ Shift-Backquote — ’ Apostrophe
 - » double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - » single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - » double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
