
Southern Tutchone Keyboard Layout



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Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: **q** is typed **a** then **Slash** /.
- To type the nasal accent use the Slash key /. e is typed e then Slash /.
- To type the rising-tone accent ' use the **Semicolon key**; \acute{e} is typed **e** then **Semicolon**;
- To type the rising-tone nasal accent 'use the Shift+Semicolon key. \(\vec{e} \) is typed \(\vec{e} \) then Shift+Semicolon.
- To type the low-tone accent `use the Grave key `. è is typed e then Grave `.
- To type the low-tone nasal accent \(\) use the Shift+Grave key. \(\varrho \) is typed \(\varrho \) then Shift+Grave.
- To type the falling-tone accent $\bar{}$ use the **Equals key** =. \bar{e} is typed e then **Equals** =.
- To type the falling nasal accent \bar{z} use the **Shift+Equals key**. \bar{e} is typed **e** then **Shift+Equals**.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Left Bracket* [is typed **Right-Alt+Left-Bracket** (Windows) **Option+Left Bracket** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - ⊳ single: 'Shift+6 —' Apostrophe
 - b double: "Right-Alt+1 "Right-Alt+2
 - single ← Right-Alt+Shift+9 → Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - b double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
