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Notes

- The special characters of Həŋqəmiŋəm have been assigned to the number keys. To type the numerals, hold down the Right-Alt or Option key then press the appropriate number key. The Numeric keypad on the right side of many keyboards keep its original numbers.
- All accents are typed after the base character: *t̂* is typed **t** then **Apostrophe** **'**.
- To type the glottalized accent *ʔ* use the **Apostrophe key** **'**. *k̂* is typed **k** then **Apostrophe** **'**.
- To type the acute accent *á* use the **Semicolon key** **;**. *á* is typed **a** then **Semicolon** **;**.
- To type the háček accent *č* use the **Shift+Grave key**. *č* is typed **c** then **Shift+Grave**. The letters *č*, *š*, *ǰ* also have their own keys: **5**, **6**, **7**.
- To type the grave accent *à* use the **Grave key** **`**. *à* is typed **a** then **Grave** **`**.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon ;** is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- There are several additional characters which can be typed holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *χ* is typed **Right-Alt+x** (Windows) **Option+x** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Left-Bracket — ’ Right-Bracket
 - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0

- All accents are typed after the base character: *t* is typed **t** then **Apostrophe** **'**.
- To type the glottalized accent ʹ use the **Apostrophe key** **'**. *k* is typed **k** then **Apostrophe** **'**.
- To type the háček accent ˇ use the **Shift+Hyphen key**. *c* is typed **c** then **Shift+Hyphen**.
- To type the acute accent ˘ use the **Grave key** **`**. *a* is typed **a** then **Grave** **`**.
- To type the grave accent ` use the **Shift+Grave key**. *a* is typed **a** then **Shift-Grave**.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon ;** is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- There are several additional characters which can be typed holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *˘* is typed **Right-Alt+x** (Windows) **Option+x** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Right-Alt+6 — ’ Shift+Comma
 - double: “ Right-Alt+7 — ” Right-Alt+7
 - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
