
## Nisga'a Keyboard

## **Notes**

- All accents are typed after the base character:  $\underline{k}$  is typed  $\underline{k}$  then **Semicolon**;
- To type the underline accent\_ use the **Semicolon key**; **g** is typed **g** then **Semicolon**;. Always use this key to type the underline accent, **never** use your word processor's underline formatting function.
- To type the apostrophe accent 'use the Slash /.  $\vec{w}$  is typed w then Slash /. This accent is not the same as the spacing apostrophe, as in  $\vec{p}$ '.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon**; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - □ single: 'Shift+Grave —' Apostrophe
  - □ double: "Shift+Left-Bracket "Shift+Right-Bracket
  - □ single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 > Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - □ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
