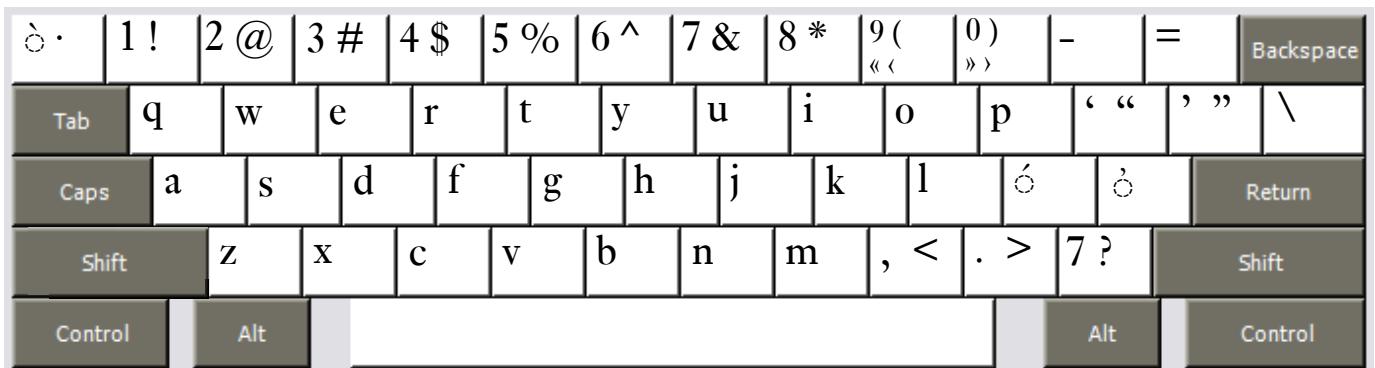


Secwepemctsín Keyboard Layout

Notes

- All accent marks are typed after the base character — *á* is typed *a* then **Semicolon** ;
- To type the acute accent ' use the **Semicolon key** ; — *ó* is typed *o* then **Semicolon** ;
- To type the grave accent ` use the **Backquote key** ` — *à* is typed *a* then **Backquote** `
- To type the apostrophe accent ' use the **Apostrophe key** ' — *p* is typed *p* then **Apostrophe** '
- The English keyboard's punctuation marks can be typed by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon** ; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Left-Bracket — ’ Right-Bracket
 - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
