Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: *á* is typed **a** then **Semicolon ;**.
- The special characters of Haitzaqvla have been assigned to the number keys. To type the numerals, hold down the **Right-Alt** or **Option** key then press the appropriate number key. The Numeric keypad on the right side of many keyboards keep its original numbers.
- To type the glottalized accent ' use the **Apostrophe key** '. *k* is typed **k** then **Apostrophe '**.
- To type the syllabic accent , use the **Zero key**. *n* is typed **n** then **Zero**.
- To type the glottalized-syllabic accent ' use the **Shift-Zero key**. *n* is typed **n** then **Shift-Zero**.
- To type the high-tone accent ´ use the **Semicolon key** ;. *e* is typed **e** then **Semicolon ;**.
- To type the high-tone-syllabic accent ´ use the **Shift-Semicolon key**. *n* is typed **n** then **Shift-Semicolon**.
- To type the grave accent ` use the **Grave key** `. *e* is typed **e** then **Grave `**.
- To type the syllabic-grave accent ` use the **Shift-Grave key**. *n* is typed **n** then **Shift-Grave**.
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon ;** is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Left-Bracket — ’ Right-Bracket
 - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0

- All accents are typed after the base character: *á* is typed **a** then **Slash /**.
- To type the glottalized accent ' use the **Apostrophe key ' .** *k̈* is typed **k** then **Apostrophe ' .**
- To type the syllabic accent , use the **Grave key ` .** *n̄* is typed **n** then **Grave ` .**
- To type the glottalized-syllabic accent , use the **Shift-Grave key.** *n̄̈* is typed **n** then **Shift-Grave.**
- To type the high-tone accent ´ use the **Slash key / .** *e´* is typed **e** then **Slash / .**
- To type the high-tone-syllabic accent ´ use the **Shift-Slash key.** *n̄´* is typed **n** then **Shift-Slash.**
- To type the háček accent ˇ use the **Equals key = .** *gˇ* is typed **g** then **Equals = .**
- All changed punctuation can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semicolon ;** is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Shift+Backslash — ’ Shift+Comma
 - double: “ Shift+Hyphen — ” Shift+Equals
 - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
