Kwakwala Keyboard Layout

Notes

- The special characters of Kwakwala have been assigned to the number keys. To type the numerals, hold down the Right-Alt or Option key then press the appropriate number key. The Numeric keypad on the right side of many keyoards keep its original numbers.
- Accents are typed after the base character: \vec{t} is typed t then Apostrophe'.
- To type the glottalized accent 'use the **Apostrophe key**'. k' is typed k then **Apostrophe**'.
- The English keyboard's punctuation marks can be typed by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Left-Bracket* [is typed **Right-Alt+Left-Bracket** (Windows) **Option+Left-Bracket** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - □ single: 'Left-Bracket 'Right-Bracket
 - □ double: "Shift+Left-Bracket "Shift+Right-Bracket
 - □ single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - □ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
