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## Notes

- The special characters of K<sup>w</sup>a<sup>k</sup>wala have been assigned to the number keys. To type the numerals, hold down the Right-Alt or Option key then press the appropriate number key. The Numeric keypad on the right side of many keyboards keep its original numbers.
- Accents are typed after the base character: *t* is typed t then **Apostrophe** '.
- To type the glottalized accent ' use the **Apostrophe key** '. *k* is typed k then **Apostrophe** '.
- The English keyboard's punctuation marks can be typed by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Left-Bracket** [ is typed **Right-Alt+Left-Bracket** (Windows) **Option+Left-Bracket** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
  - single: ‘ Left-Bracket — ’ Right-Bracket
  - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
  - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
  - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
