Notes

- All accents are typed after the base character: *é* is typed **e** then **Slash /**.
- To type the acute accent *´* use the **Slash key /**. *á* is typed **a** then **Slash /**.
- To type the grave accent *`* use the **Grave key `**. *à* is typed **a** then **Grave `**.
- To type the dot accent *˙* use the **Left Bracket key [**. *ñ* is typed **h** then **Left Bracket [**.
- To type the underdot accent *˘* use the **Right Bracket key]**. *ḵ* is typed **k** then **Right Bracket]**.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Semicolon ;* is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Shift+Grave — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Bracket
 - single ‹ Right-Alt+Shift+9 — › Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
