


Hidatsa Keyboard Layout



Notes

- Accents are typed before the base letter.
- The acute accent ‘ is on the **Semicolon key**; ‘A is typed **Semicolon** then **A**.
- The glottal stop ? letter is on the **Slash key** /.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The *Slash* / is typed **Right-Alt+Slash** (Windows) **Option+Slash** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - single: ‘ Grave — ’ Apostrophe
 - double: “ Shift+Left-Bracket — ” Shift+Right-Backslash
 - single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 — > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - double « Right-Alt+9 — » Right-Alt+0
