
Isga I²abi (Stoney Nakoda) Keyboard Layout



Notes

- To type the circumflex accent $\hat{}$ use the **Semicolon key**;. Thus \hat{a} is typed a then **Semicolon**.
- The glottal stop character ? is on the Slash key /.
- The digraphs rh and th can be typed two different ways:
 - Using the Left-Bracket (for rh) and the Right-Bracket (for th) keys.
 - \Box Holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key** then typing either **r** or **t**.
- In Windows, to type the all-caps versions of <u>RH</u> and <u>TH</u>, you will need to use the **Shift+Semicolon** key for the underline accent _. Thus <u>RH</u> is typed R: H: Mac users can simply use Caps-Lock.
- All changed keys can type their original value by holding down the **Right-Alt** or **Option key**. The **Semi-colon**; is typed **Right-Alt+Semicolon** (Windows) **Option+Semicolon** (Mac).
- Opening and closing quotes. For Mac users, Right-Alt is either of the Option Keys.
 - □ single: 'Grave —' Apostrophe
 - □ double: "Backslash "Shift+Backslash
 - □ single < Right-Alt+Shift+9 > Right-Alt+Shift+0
 - □ double « Right-Alt+9 » Right-Alt+0
