

# Dene Syllabics Keyboard Layout



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## Notes

- Some of the syllabics finals may be ambiguous on the map above:
  - ▶ The w-dot is on the **backquote key**, as in  $\underline{\text{w}}$  - not to be confused with the period  $\text{w}$ .
  - ▶ The p-final is on the **shift-W key**, as in  $\underline{\text{p}}$  - the ejective diacritic is on the **slash key**, as in  $\underline{\text{p}}$ .
  - ▶ The k-final is on the **shift-R key**, as in  $\underline{\text{k}}$  - the nasal diacritic is on the **z key**, as in  $\underline{\text{k}}$ .
  - ▶ The m-final is on the **shift-Y key**, as in  $\underline{\text{m}}$  - the aspirate diacritic is on the **x key**, as in  $\underline{\text{m}}$ .
  - ▶ The y-final is on the **shift-P key**, as in  $\underline{\text{y}}$  - not to be confused with the plus-sign  $\pm$ .
  - ▶ For convenience, the t-final is on the **m key**, as in  $\underline{\text{t}}$ .
- On Macs, when the **CAPS-LOCK** is turned on, the keyboard reverts to a US English layout.
- By holding down the **Right-Alt key (Windows)** or **Option key (Mac)**, it is possible to access the numbers and punctuation marks as mapped on a US English keyboard.
